Audience Discussion MV Div

- Cedar Grove (CDC):
 - Stigma reduction, conflict resolution via NCU \$250k allocation in FY 2010-11
 - Community Centre expansion
- Balvenie Drive (Mr. Myers):
 - Poor road condition related to Housing development works/heavy eqpmt. Plea for repairs to potholes. Traffic buildup on Perth
 - (Cllr Porteous): MPC has done minor patching. developers should be made to pay.

Audience Discussion – MV Div

- **Balvenie Dr - Housing Scheme (con'td)**
 - MP to meet with NHDC officer soon
 - Piping already underway. Representation to be made for interim mitigation
- - (Byron Farquharson) – could road be upgraded to accommodate more traffic?
 - Scope is beyond CDF Budget, may need community partnership
 - MPC has to enforce regulations on commercial operations
- Perth Road (J. Oliphant) – needs a comprehensive development review. Re-routing may be more feasible than trying to widen Perth Road.
- (Danny Rumel, MCOC) – consider acquiring nearby lands for road expansion

Audience Discussion – KP Div

- (Mr. Fletcher, Knockpatrick Citz. Assocn.)– **Anna Miller Basic School** Board: School needs proper electricity supply/ lighting. Affects classes and community meetings. Needs landscaping. Vulnerable to break-ins.
 - MP & Cllr. Porteous agree for School to be a Polling Station
- MP to visit site over weekend
- (Ms. Peart) – City Mission Basic in Albion needs electricity and play area equipment (swing, slide, etc)
- Ms. Sutherland – Heartease Comm Ctr needs water. Owner/tenureship documents unknown. LAMP to be explored

Audience Discussion – RF Div

- **Road network**
- **Community Policing** – Comfort, Royal Flat & Heartease. Janice Ledgister (SDC Comm'ty Officer) – stakeholder meeting coming up to address concerns. JCF not yet represented at Safety & Security meetings.
- Rose Griffiths (SDC) – Community Safety & Secur (National) programme is different from Comm Policing (local). Challenges arise from leadership turnover e.g JCF Supt of Police.
- Sgt ?? (Sub-officer i.c.) – fear causing low turnout to Comm Policing meetings. Cllr Mitchell (R. Flat) – JCF lack of funding for vehicles, etc contributed to breakdown.

Audience Discussion – BF Div


- **Zion Hill Primary** (Mayor Ramsay) – needs floors, water supply. MP to make representation to Ministry of Educ
- **Top Coffee Grove Basic** – needs bathrooms & additional classrooms. May be done in phases.
- **Blue Mountain School** – barren
- **Battery Walls** for embankments throughout the division. Unsafe.
- Little farming landspace. Protected Farming for agro-entrepreneurship.

Audience Discussion – BF Div

- **Farming** (cont'd)- Greenhouses and other advanced technologies are expensive.
- Mr. Harris (RADA) – other cost-efficient options exist. A Demonstration or Model farms may be done.
- Mayor Ramsay – Content community - **water supply** needed.
- Paul Grant (BF Prim. Sch.) – offering old school building for community skills training partners. HEART/NTA has not taken up offer.
